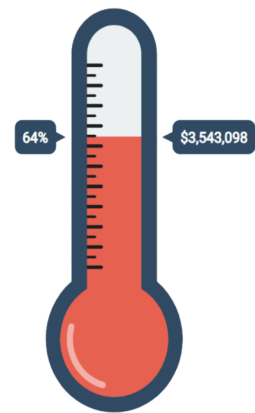
- **Stations of the Cross:** During Lent, Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday at 5:20 PM. The faithful are encouraged to attend.

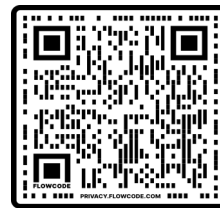
